**RESOLUTION NO. 06.13.2026**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADVERTISEMENT, HIRING, AND APPOINTMENT OF FOUR (4) SEASONAL DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS LABORERS FOR THE SUMMER OF 2026**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Kinnelon Department of Public Works experiences an increased workload during the summer months related to maintenance, landscaping, parks, facilities, and public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the hiring of seasonal laborers is necessary to assist the Department of Public Works in meeting its operational needs during this period; and

WHEREAS, funds have been appropriated in the 2026 Municipal Budget for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to advertise for and hire four (4) seasonal laborers to assist the Department of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Kinnelon, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Borough Administrator and Superintendent of Public Works are hereby authorized to advertise for and recruit four (4) Seasonal Department of Public Works Laborers.
2. The Borough Administrator is hereby authorized to hire and appoint up to four (4) Seasonal Department of Public Works Laborers, subject to the completion of all required employment documentation and background checks, if applicable.
3. The seasonal laborers shall be compensated at a rate of Eighteen Dollars (\$18.00) per hour.
4. Employment shall commence on or about July 6, 2026, and shall conclude on or about September 4, 2026, unless terminated earlier by the Borough or extended by further action of the Mayor and Council.
5. The seasonal laborers shall work under the supervision of the Superintendent of Public Works and shall perform duties as assigned.
6. The Borough Clerk, Borough Administrator, Chief Financial Officer, and Superintendent of Public Works are hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
