ORDINANCE NO. 3-// AN ORDINANCE TO AMENDING CHAPTER 53, PERSONNEL POLICIES, SECTION 53-2 ADOPTION OF POLICY

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Kinnelon ("Borough") desires to amend Chapter 53 <u>Personnel Policies</u>, Section 53-2, <u>Adoption of Policy</u>.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Kinnelon, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 53, <u>Personnel Policies</u>, Section 53-2, <u>Adoption of Policy</u>, of the "Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Kinnelon" is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 53-2. Adoption of Policy

The Borough of Kinnelon Personnel Policy, dated March 2010, is hereby adopted by the Borough of Kinnelon, and its provisions as may be amended from time to time shall be deemed controlling with respect to all matters addressed therein, particularly the rights, duties, benefits, terms and conditions of employment and evaluation procedures for those employees specified in §53-1.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court or federal or state agency of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES. Ordinances, resolutions, and regulations or parts of ordinances, resolutions, and regulations inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
