## ORDINANCE NO. 2-/5 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 13-5, COMMITTEES, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF KINNELON

WHEREAS, §13-5(C) of the Code of the Borough of Kinnelon ("Borough") provides for the establishment of standing committees of the Borough of Kinnelon and §13-6 provides for the duties of each standing committee; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to add a standing committee for Information Technology.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Kinnelon, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- §13-5 shall be amended at Paragraph C to add Information Technology as the tenth standing committee; and
- §13-6 shall be amended to as follows:
  - J- Information Technology Committee. The Information Technology Committee shall have the primary responsibility for the following described activities and matters:
  - a) Reviewing information technology policy, records, practices and procedures annually and making recommendations thereon to the governing body.
  - b) Acting as liaison to all departments to resolve technology problems.
  - c) Maintaining an understanding of the evolving issues in technology and their applicability to Municipal Government.

SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court or federal or state agency of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES. Ordinances, resolutions, and regulations or parts of ordinances, resolutions, and regulations inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
