## Old Business:

Morris County Historic Preservation Trust (large grant money): Tom Kline-1) Electrical engineer came today to begin process of defining scope of work to get electric restored at the museum. Should finish after first of year. 2) Margaret wants to file a letter of intent for a grant that's due the end of February w/Morris Co. to pay for this. Trying to determine how much is due to fire regarding the insurance payment. Things we don't need such as plugs are going to be buried, capped off, disconnected or covered up-to minimize disruption to finish. Have to pay prevailing wage if over @\$18,000-part has to be covered by fire insurance. Insurance will pay for any damage caused by fire, putting it out, how fire started-but not rewiring the building. 3) Highlights-outlets will be abandoned, abandon plugs, no re-wiring of stove, outdoor electrical in porch, cables with cloth around it will get replaced. Exit signs to be replaced. Plan is developing -more news in January. 4) Margaret will try to include leaded upper gutter with grant @ approx. \$15,000.

Morris County Heritage Commission History Re-Grant Program (small grant money): Tom Kline-Laura filed final report; all okay with Morris County.

**Building and Grounds Report:** Jim Roselius-Mostly all painted. Porch flooring still needs to be done. They need to finish painting the doors-need someone to be there to open the doors. Painted the risers. Leave paint for posts. Door above garage hard to close; ripped off weather stripping to at least be able to close the door.
